

## Sports Funding Statement

The government has provided £150 million per annum for primary school sports funding.

The funding is being jointly provided by Departments for Education; Health; and Culture, Media and Sport. Money is going directly to primary schools to spend on improving the quality of Sport and PE for all children in school.

Our grant is delegated as follows: Based on the number of Eligible Pupils on roll in September 2016

Total Grant Academic Year 2016/2017 £8604

Testwood College Schools Sports Partnership (training for staff and events for children) £643 (reduced rate as less activities this year due to staffing changes at Partnership)

REAL PE training for new staff £485

Tennis teaching for Year One - £280

Sports week (tennis, golf, dance, Yoga)

Inter schools competitions (football, cross country, multi skills) £1200

Play equipment –basketball hoops, climbing frame (to develop core stability and give children more opportunities at playtimes) £3605

Resources for Lunchtime play and P.E. £1250

Equipment storage container to enable bikes etc to be stored safely (increased vandalism) £800
