



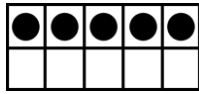

This week in maths we have been using multi-representations to learn the numbers 1-5. We have used a variety of resources and introduced the children

The sounds learnt this week have been:

th, z, ch and qu

We have begun to blend these letter sounds into words such as:

thin, thumb, zip, chip, chop,
quiz and quit

Remember when you see two sounds together ie. th they are special friends and make one sound.

Our red word of the week is

no

We have been exploring how to use this word when we speak.

E.g.

No thank you.

Or

No sweets today!
