Cooking

This week the children made jam/lemon tarts. They rolled out the dough and used cutters to create their case. Then they spooned either jam or lemon curd into their tart. We baked them in the oven for 15-20 minutes until golden brown. Hope the children enjoyed eating them for their tea!



Maths

Continuing with our maths, we have explored 1 more and 1 less using objects, ten-frames, numicon pieces and 1p's. We have discussed what it means to have 1 more and 1 less. Using a number card, the children selected a card then thought about what number came next. E.G. 1 more than 7 is 8.

Home learning: In your discussions, can your children tell you 1 more than a given number e.g. 1 more than 9 is 10.

said

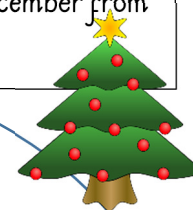
We have been exploring how to use this word when we speak. E.g.
