It was lovely to see so many of you at the nativity, I'm sure you'll agree they looked and sounded fantastic. We were very proud of them.

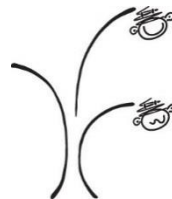
