Maths - We will:

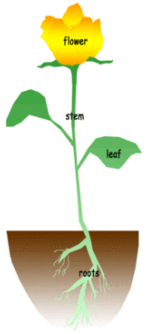
- * Adding and subtracting within 20 using a range of resources including a number line.
- * Learning about place value of numbers up to 50 and representing this using tens and ones.
- * Learning about more than/ less than using < > inequality symbols.
- * Counting in 5s to help us with multiplication
- * Learning about length and height

Identify and name common wild and garden plants including deciduous and evergreen trees.
