Writing a Riddle

This week in literacy we explored riddles. We discussed what a riddle is and how we can write our own set of clues for a farm animal riddle.

Here is a riddle for you:

I am black and white

I live on the farm

I like to chew grass

I say moo moo

What am I?

Can you think of anymore riddles for your favourite farm animal?

Double trouble

We started our maths learning this week by helping the poor farmer who had double the number of sheep to look after. We discussed that the number doubled had to be the same and each time the number increased by 2. We spotted the pattern using the 100 square.

Phonics

We use our phonic knowledge to help us in our writing every day.

Think it, say it, and write it,

This helps the children to focus on what they want to write.

Can you have a go at home? You could write about our trip to the farm.

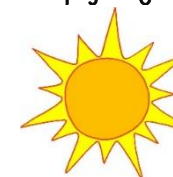
Challenge time
