### PSHE – All About Me

We have had a lovely time sharing our 'All About Me' books this week.

In our colour groups we looked at our books and shared our favourite parts. We looked at our teachers' books too! We also spoke about our feelings and how we can manage our feelings when we are feeling sad or angry and spoke about gentle hands and being a good friend.

### Early maths.

We have been focusing closely on numbers 1-8 over the last couple of weeks. A crucial part of early maths is ensuring children have a deep basic number knowledge which involves children being able to understand the number as an amount and represent it in different ways using different resources as well as rote counting. In subsequent weeks we will move on to teen numbers.
